Description of Student Scholarships & Awards

President's Scholarship

Awarded to a P1, P2, P3, and P4 student who demonstrates leadership inside and outside of the classroom.

Dean's Student of the Year Award

Awarded to a P1, P2, P3 and P4 student that has displayed leadership, service, professionalism, and served as an advocate for the profession of pharmacy.

Student Researcher of the Year

Awarded to a P1, P2, P3, and P4 student that has achieved a high level of research and scholarly activities at CNUCOP.

Student Community Service and Leadership Award

Awarded to a P1, P2, and P3 student that has demonstrated exceptional leadership skills and is actively engaged in community outreach through their role within a CNUCOP student organization.

Academic Excellence Award

Academic-based award given to a student from the P1, P2, and P3 class that has maintained academic excellence based on their cumulative grade point average.

Layla Kassem Scholarship

Awarded to a P4 student in good academic standing with demonstrated financial need.

CNU Alumni Scholarship

Awarded to a student in good academic standing who shown CNU collegiality, as evidenced by their participation in the classroom, college committees, leadership roles, and as an active member of the student body.

Northern California Education Foundation (NCEF) Scholarships

Description of Student Scholarships & Awards

CVS Bilingual Community Pharmacy Scholarship

Awarded to P1s-P4s who have been active in community service activities promoting public health intiaitives, such as combatting the COVID-19 pandemic.


Milestone Scholars






