



## PHARMACOLOGY FACULTY POSITION

Applications and nominations are invited for a full-time faculty position in the Department of Pharmaceutical and Biomedical Sciences at California Northstate University College of Pharmacy. The successful applicant is expected to teach pharmacology to Pharm.D. students and to initiate and actively participate in a research program in their area of interest, preferably in collaboration with other faculty members at the university. Other responsibilities will include mentoring students; service to the College and University; and additional responsibilities to advance the College and University.

The ideal candidate should have the following attributes and qualifications:

- A background in pharmacology preferably in the area of renal and respiratory;
- A Ph.D., Pharm.D., or equivalent terminal degree;
- Teaching experience in a doctor of pharmacy program;
- Experience in research and scholarship;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills; and
- Ability to work within a team structure.

Applications will continue to be accepted until the position is filled. Rank and salary will be commensurate with experience. Informal inquiries are welcome. Please submit your application as one PDF file containing the following elements in the order given:

3. Teaching statement (not more than 2 pages)
4. Research statement (not more than 2 pages)
