Free CE Training on Drug Abuse Topics

Pharmacists can earn up to seven hours of free continuing education credit at a day of training sessions on July 28 near Sacramento.

The day-long event is sponsored by the California Board of Pharmacy at California Northstate Pharmacy in Elk Grove. Session topics include:

- Drug diversion trends, counterfeit prescriptions, and pharmacy burglaries and robberies.
- Loss prevention in pharmacies.
- Corresponding responsibility.
- Pharmacy law update.
- How to prepare for pharmacy inspections by the Board of Pharmacy and the Drug Enforcement Administration.
- California's prescription drug monitoring program – CURES.
- Providing naloxone pursuant to the California pharmacist protocol.

Pharmacists will be awarded six hours of CE credit for attending the day-long event. An additional hour – for a total of seven hours of CE credit – can be earned for attending the session on providing naloxone to meet the training requirement of the naloxone protocol.
